ORDER

The following are the payment guidelines for all unpaid costs, fines and restitution requested to be paid pursuant to deferred or installment payment agreements.

- 1. All unpaid costs and fines totaling more than \$50.00 are eligible for an installment or deferred payment agreement.
- The defendant must appear, in person, in the Circuit Court Clerk's Office and request to make installment payments and will be required to sign form CC-1379 Order and Notice of Deferred Payment or Installment Payments, which will serve as the agreement between the defendant and the Court.
- 3. If the defendant is incarcerated or unable to appear, the form can be mailed or faxed to the defendant, signed and returned to the Clerk.
- 4. Payments are due every 30 days. The minimum payment is \$50.00 per month. The first payment is due the month immediately following the month in which the application was made.
- 5. If paying by mail, a self-addressed and stamped envelope is required for the return of a receipt. The case number must be on the payment.
- 6. Default on agreements will require the defendant to complete a new petition for installment or deferred payment, subject to the approval of the Clerk of the Court.
- 7. The defendant must inform the Court promptly of any change of address during the term of the agreement.
