

VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY OF CULPEPER

RE: COURTHOUSE SECURITY (Effective March 18, 2019)


**ORDER**

The following policy regarding Courthouse Security shall be in effect as of March 18, 2019:

1. Persons entering the Courthouse are required to pass through the metal detector; personal effects such as purses, handbags, and briefcases must also be scanned. Local attorneys and attorneys with active Virginia State Bar cards, as well as Courthouse personnel, are exempt;
2. Persons entering the metal detector are subject to further search if the metal detector sounds a notification indicating further scanning/searching is warranted;
3. Except for emergencies, unauthorized entrance to the secured area (inmate holding/General District rear hallway) is prohibited;
4. These changes are to enhance the security and safety of all persons entering and conducting business within the Culpeper County Courthouse.

This policy regarding Courthouse Security shall be posted on the Court's home page on the Virginia Judicial System website; on the Court's local website (if any); at the Courthouse entrance; and, in the Clerk's Office of each Court.
